#### **SCHEDULE**

Friday, the weekend begins at 3:00 PM until 5:00 PM with registration in our private hotel bungalow on the grounds of the hotel. We will have this room available to us for the entire weekend to serve as our Hospitality suite and for event registration. Dinner will take place pool side beginning at 7:00 PM after no host cocktails at 6:00 PM.

Saturday the Grand Classic will begin with car placement on the hotel lawn beginning at 8:00 AM. The Hospitality Suite will also open at 8:00 AM. The Judges and Tabulators breakfast will begin at 8:30 AM in the Croquet Cottage. Judging will begin at 10:00 AM.

The hotel will make food and drinks available for purchase near the field and there will be many other options available for breakfast, lunch and snacks, all within a few steps of the hotel. Breakfast can be enjoyed on the terrace at the hotel overlooking the field or at Thyme in the Ranch bakery or great coffee can be purchased at a tiny coffee shop called Positano. And, ice cream, snacks and sandwiches can be purchased throughout the day at numerous spots around the village.

Saturday night events will begin at 6:30 PM with no host cocktails on the Azalea lawn, followed by a sit down dinner in the Azalea Room at 7:30 PM. Dinner will be followed by the awards ceremony and a photographic presentation of the Classics displayed.

Sunday the cars can begin moving off the lawn at 8:00 AM if they are still on the lawn from the day before. Sunday morning we will caravan to Torrey Pines providing views of stunning cliffs and picturesque beaches to the private collection of San Diego/Palm Springs member John Ellison who has graciously opened his renowned collection to our group that day.

Carl Zeiger, Grand Classic Coordinator is promising a wonderful event in a beautiful part of the country and asks you to mark your calendars now and to please make every effort to attend this fantastic event. # **GRAND CLASSIC CAR REGISTRATION FORM**



- 1. To enter a car in the Grand Classic, fill in the form completely. Incomplete entries will be returned to owner for missing information. Include the appropriate fees for the Division you enter. For additional entries, use facsimile forms and include appropriate fee for each car. Please print or type the form.
- 2. Be sure to indicate correctly the Division in which you wish to enter your car. A car judged in the wrong Division will be disqualified and any award will be forfeited. For further information, consult your current CCCA *Handbook and Members Roster*.
- 3. Make your check or money order (in U.S. funds) payable to: Classic Car Club of America. Send the registration form and your remittance to: Classic Car Club of America, 5100 River Road, Suite 175, Schiller Park, IL 60176.
- 4. Regular entries for these Grand Classics must be postmarked no later than the **regular deadlines** listed on the form below. Late entries for judging include a \$20.00 surcharge for processing and must be postmarked no later than the **late fee deadlines** listed on the form below.
- 5. Dinner reservations are NOT to be sent with car entries. Instructions and the proper form for dinner reservations are on the activity flyer page opposite.
- 6. IMPORTANT NO CLASSIC WILL BE JUDGED OR EXHIBITED WITHOUT PROPER LIABILITY INSURANCE. SHOW INSURANCE CARRIER AND POLICY NUMBER ON REGISTRATION FORM.
- 7. To be judged in National meets, a SENIOR Classic must have affixed, visible to the exterior of the car, the Senior recognition badge. A car entered in Premier Division MUST have affixed to their car, and around the Senior badge, the oval Senior-Winner-recognition badge. A Premier Classic must visibly affix the Premier crown.
- 8. Senior Emeritus "Judging" is open to any Senior and Premier Classic that has won a first place in its respective Division not less than three years prior to the present competition. Multiple awards will be made to cars scoring 93 points or more. No scores will be a announced, recorded or returned to the owner.
- 9. Senior Emeritus "Judging" is open to all Senior and Premier Classics that have won a first place in their respective Divisions not less than three years prior to the present competition. Multiple awards will be made to cars scoring 93 points or more. No scores will be announced, recorded or returned to the owner.
- 10. Classics to be judged or exhibited MUST have U.L. approved fire extinguishers in the car.
- 11. Altered and New Coachwork Classics may be exhibited at National meets only after acceptance by the Classification Committee. Consult your current CCCA *Handbook and Members Roster* under "Modified/Altered/New Coachwork Classic Division."
- 12. All Classics will be required to stay in the judging area until judging is completed.
- 13. All wishing to judge, check and remit registration card even though you may not be entering a car for judging.
