Information for you to read & keep

Staging time is from 8:30am to 9:45 am. The day of the show, Drive in safe go right to space dont stop and hold up traffic. **Read the map and staging instructions you recieve by mail before you arrive.**

You will recieve a staging map a couple weeks prior to the show. Please park in the space thats highlighted on the map. Even if you have an issue to discuss park in the space on the map. (To prevent congestion in the lot)

Once you are parked, go to the check in booth pick up shirt, goodie bag (if we recieve goodies) voting slips, voucher for coffee and donuts. At that time if you have an issue you need to discuss ask to speak to Maria after you pick up all the stuff you need. This way the line won't be held up and you wont have to get back in line.

This is a family orientated event: Please smoke in the designated area or away from guest/children or show vehicles. Alcohol & Marajuna are NOT allowed at the show. (Please place trash in trash boxes/cans.)

Car Show Coordinator: Thats me, I'm the only one the museum has, in the 4 days before the show I'm busy pulling it altogether for a safe and organized show. Please if you have questions/issues don't wait till the few days or day before to contact me. I am not Super Woman, Thank You!

Open Header: Check the box on application to be in this: 1- Trophy Awarded (I plan on running this by coming to you at the designated show space you are parked at.) If we get a mega response I may divide this up Big Block/Small Block. In this case 1 – Trophy each class.

Class Definitions:

Customs = More radical modifications, chopped tops, low rider, hopper etc. & or more than 3 modifications.

Muscle = 1961-74 American, 2 door high performance V8 engine.

Special Interest = 1995 and earlier, race cars, kit cars, rat rods, theme cars, foreign cars or anything that does not fit the listed classes must run.

Street Rod = Was manufactured prior to 1949 or was manufactured to resemble a motor vehicle manufactured prior to 1949; May be equipped with a drive train, suspension system or brake system that is different from the drive train or the brake system originally installed on the vehicle; May have alterations to the dimensions of the original body of the vehicle; and is not a motorcycle or an assembled vehicle.

Gasser = A gasser is a vintage **drag car** that was popularized in the '50s and '60s. Its name comes from the fact that it runs on gasoline instead of race fuel. Classic gassers are nostalgic muscle cars with large engines that are modified for speed.

Classic Low-rider = An American made, customized vehicle with hydraulic jacks that allow the chassis to be lowered nearly to the ground; Popular car years are 1940's, 50's, 60's.
