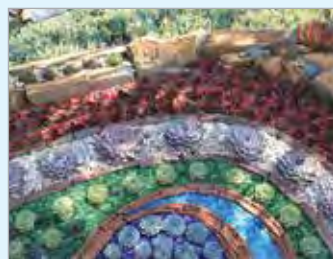
Thursday, meet up in the hotel lobby to pick up your registration materials and start the fun!
