TMPCC's ANNUAL CAR SHOW AT CBS STUDIO CENTER **FRIDAY JULY 4, 2014 - FROM 4:30 PM TO 10:00 PM**



The world's only entertainment industry car club, the Television Motion Picture Car Club (TMPCC) will host their 5th Annual Car Show in conjunction with the Fireworks Festival at CBS Studio Center at 4024 Radford Avenue in Studio City, California on Friday July 4th. This is a family friendly event with food, drink, live musical entertainment, performances by world class magicians, activities for the children, our car show and one of the best fireworks displays in Los Angeles. Plus how often do you get the opportunity to be a spectator or participate in a car show held at a historic television and motion picture studio? This is a fantastic way to spend Independence Day!

TMPCC is opening up the show to a very small number of non-member vehicles for 2014. That means you could be displaying your vehicle at the studio this year. If you are accepted, you will have the opportunity to vie for one of the 12 CBS/TMPCC awards. These include the Top Ten Best of Show, the Overall Best of Show, and the President's Award. The car show portion of the festival is an intimate affair, with a neighborhood car show feel. A maximum of 70 vehicles will be on display, and that means all the vehicles get a fair amount of attention and won't get lost in a sea of hundreds or thousands of cars. This also means that participants have a better than one in 6 chance of winning an award. Plus this is the only car show in the world where you can win an award with the logo of a major television studio on it.

TMPCC does not charge a registration fee for the vehicles that are displayed at our Annual Car Show, but you must send us a picture of your vehicle and request an event invitation by writing us at tmpcc@tmpcc.org – If you are accepted, you will receive a Confirmation email before you are allowed to display your vehicle at this year's event.

In addition to all our member's vehicles that will be on display, our friends from the television series "Rods n' Wheels" are planning to bring one of their creations from "Da Rod Shop". Kenny Fong of Darkside Motoring is bringing one of his rides. Cord Bauer of Bauer Limited is bringing "The Catfish" (the car is only now starting to get some press, so the majority of the public have not seen this car in person yet). If their schedules allow, Alex "The Car Girl" Rogeo plans to display her Dodge Magnum Drag Car and Michael Essa is planning to display his championship winning BMW drift car. Thanks to our members at Team Killeen, Cadillac is supplying one of their new ELR's. Member Cynthia Carpenter is bringing one of her Indianapolis Race Cars that participants and spectators can sit in and take pictures for the cost of a \$1.00 raffle ticket. Purchasing a raffle ticket also gives you a chance to win a seat in one of nitro burning top fuel race cars when they are fired up for the crowd (in addition to racing team jersey's and other cool prizes). Thanks to our Race Car Coordinator John Ewald, we will continue our tradition of firing up some nitro methane drag cars at the show. One vehicle will be fired up every hour starting at 5:00 pm. The last firing will be at 8:00 pm, one hour before the fireworks light up the sky and will feature former actor, Drag Racing Legend and TMPCC member "TV Tommy Ivo", who will take the seat of his beautifully restored 1964 front engine Barnstormer dragster (owned by fellow member Ron Johnson). "The King of the Kustomizers" and TMPCC member George Barris is also planning to attend, along with our members from Picture Car Warehouse and Studio Picture Vehicles who will display some very special screen used vehicles; and that's just a small sample of what you can expect to see at CBS Studio Center this July 4th.

Spectator tickets can be purchased at the studio on July 4th starting at 4:30PM. Ticket prices for spectators are: \$20 for adults (age 13 and up); children 6-12 are \$10; and those age 5 and under are FREE. All proceeds benefit charity.
