## **TMPCC's ANNUAL CAR SHOW AT CBS STUDIO CENTER** **MONDAY JULY 4, 2016 - 4:30 PM TO 9:30 PM**



The Television Motion Picture Car Club (the world's only entertainment industry car club) will host their 7<sup>th</sup> Annual Car Show in conjunction with the Studio City Fireworks Festival at CBS Studio Center at 4024 Radford Avenue in Studio City, California on Monday July 4<sup>th</sup>. This is a family friendly event with food, drink, live musical entertainment, activities for the children, the TMPCC car show and one of the best fireworks displays in Southern California. Plus how often do you get the opportunity to participate in or be a spectator at a car show held at a historic television and motion picture studio that was once home to Republic Studios.

This year's theme is "July 4<sup>th</sup> Fireworks and Luau" so don your best Hawaiian shirt or put on the good ole red, white and blue. Live musical entertainment will be a tribute to Elvis and the proceeds from this year's event benefit the Children's Tumor Foundation.

The car show is booked, but if you would like to register, we will place you on our backup list. Should we receive any cancellations, we will pull those from our backup list in the order your registration was received. That means you just might have the opportunity to display your vehicle at the studio this year. If you are accepted, you will be eligible to win one of the twelve CBS/TMPCC awards that will be presented. The car show portion of the event has a friendly, small town neighborhood feel, and this is the only car show in the world where you can win an award with the logo of a major television studio on it.

We do not charge a registration fee for the vehicles on display at our show, but you must send us a picture of your vehicle and request an invitation by writing us at [tmpcc@tmpcc.org](mailto:tmpcc@tmpcc.org) – If we receive any cancellations and you are accepted, you will receive a confirmation email letting you know you are in this year's show.

Some of the vehicles on display this year include Rick Dore's latest masterpiece "Aquarius" designed and built for Metallica front man James Hetfield. Actress, model and spokesperson Alex "The Car Girl" Rogeo will be displaying her Dodge Magnum drag car. Automotive designer Larry Weiner will be displaying a Mr. Norm's GSS Hurst Edition Supercat Dodge Challenger. AAA Automobile Club of Southern California will display the AAA sponsored funny car of Robert Hight from John Force Racing. Since we are an entertainment industry car club, we will also have some industry vehicles on display, including Shotmaker 11, a famous camera car that was used on many television and motion picture productions over the years, including: The A-Team, Christine, The Fall Guy, Nash Bridges, Short Circuit, Starman, Sudden Impact, and many more. Next Pictures will have several screen used vehicles on display, including tribute vehicles from Back to the Future. Studio Picture Vehicles will be displaying a van from the hit show NCIS, as well as a Scooby Doo van the children will enjoy. And that is just a very small sample of some of the vehicles you will see at CBS Studio Center July 4<sup>th</sup>.

Former "Stig" from Top Gear UK, stunt and precision driver, race car driver and TMPCC member Ben Collins is flying in from England to do a signing of his latest book "How to Drive" that was just released here in the United States. Ben is also the stunt driver for Daniel Craig in the James Bond movies, he drove the Batmobile Tumbler in "The Dark Knight Rises", drove vehicles in Fast and Furious 6, Mission Impossible: Rogue Nation, Knight and Day and many others. Legendary Disney Imagineer Bob Gurr will also be on hand to sign DVD's about his life. Bob has worked on countless projects, not only for Disney, but for many other studios as well. Two examples include helping with the design of the King Kong exhibit for Universal Studios and helping bring the T-Rex to life for Steven Spielberg's blockbuster motion picture Jurassic Park.

We will have a charity raffle with some great prizes, including automotive detailing products from Liquid Glow. The Grand Prize will be two full day passes to any Disney Theme Park in the world.
