


The area is steeped in culture and history, from the historic Mulholland Highway, Hollywood, ocean and mountain vistas and the historic California Missions. It's a great place to live. The Early Ford V8 Club of America Ventura Region #84 is looking forward to showing you a great time while you are visiting Ventura County.

There are some great raffle prizes in the works; a restored gas pump, a beautiful quilt, plus many more items. So start thinking about those raffle tickets. The raffle room will be a must visit several times during your stay. We will also have a Swap Meet and Vendor area this year. You will want to take a stroll through their areas to see what they have to offer.

There are several great events planned and we hope you will be able to join us. We are going to start the week off with a Welcome Party at the Hyatt Westlake Plaza Thousand Oaks from 5-8pm Tuesday evening. Join us and catch up with old friends and meet new friends as you mingle and enjoy a slice of pizza and salad.

Wednesday is set aside for car clean-up; Ladies Luncheon will be in the afternoon and seminars. At this time we are working on several different seminars. All seminars are free, just come, enjoy and learn at the same time. Seminar times and locations will be posted in the hotel lobby.

Thursday is a busy day, starting off with concourse judging. Be sure to rest up in the afternoon as we have an event planned in the evening you won't want to miss! Thursday evening we will be having a BBQ and a concert at the Camarillo Ranch House, in Camarillo, California about 15 minutes away. Music industry veterans, Caught Red Handed will be entertaining us tonight. They have been playing in Ventura County since 1988 and have shared the stage with many well-known country artists such as Vince Gill, Martina McBride, Sarah Evans, Toby Keith, Randy Travis, and many more. This is a band whose appeal stems not only from their vocal talents and musicianship, but also their humor and ability to draw and keep the attention of every crowd. They have a great sound that all will thoroughly enjoy.

As you might guess, one of the towns in Ventura County is named after the Camarillo Family. To give you a little history of the Camarillo Ranch, read the following quote;

"The Camarillo Ranch was originally a 10,000 acre Spanish land grant created in 1837, patented to Gabriel Ruiz in 1866, and then purchased by Juan Camarillo in 1875. His son Adolfo built the Queen Anne Victorian home in 1892. Later the barn and stables were added to support the agricultural work and house the renowned Camarillo White Horses. Today the ranch is owned by the City of Camarillo and operated by the non-profit Camarillo Ranch Foundation."



"The Camarillo White Horses became famous over the years as they paraded and performed at fiestas and other activities. They became well known at the Pasadena Rose Parades; attended the parade to open the Oakland Bay Bridge; a Los Angeles parade to raise war bonds; and went to the Santa Barbara Fiesta parades since they began in the '30's. Often dignitaries would be seen riding the Camarillo White Horses, including: President Harding, Governor Ronald Reagan; John Mott; movie star Leo Carrillo; and the son of President Gerald Ford."

As you can see this beautiful ranch has a lot to offer. Docents will be available to take you on tours of this 120 year-old home. So be sure to join us for a fun evening of food and entertainment.

To top off Thursday we have saved the best for last, Friday we will be visiting Paramount Ranch! Hidden in Agoura Hills, California is an old western movie set; this western town has been the setting for many western movies dating back to the 1920's. We will visit the set where "Dr. Quinn Medicine Woman", starring Jane Seymour, was filmed, along with many, many, many old movies. While there join us for a Tri-tip BBQ with all the fixings. After lunch you will have the option of sitting and enjoying the views or going on many pre-planned driving tours that we have planned for you.

"In 1927, Paramount Pictures purchased 2,700 acres of the old Rancho Las Virgenes for use as a "movie ranch." For 25 years, a veritable who's who of Hollywood practiced their craft at Paramount Ranch including director Cecil B. Demille and actors Bob Hope, Gary Cooper and Claudette Colbert. The diverse landscape was the real star of the show. It offered film makers the freedom to create distant locales such as colonial Massachusetts in The Maid of Salem (1937), ancient China in The Adventures of Marco Polo (1938), a South Seas island in Ebb Tide (1937) and numerous western locations including San Francisco in Wells Fargo. The art of illusion was mastered on the landscape."

As evening is approaching join us back at the Hyatt for Happy Hour prior to the Awards Banquet. Join us in honoring all the fantastic cars that will be receiving awards this evening. As we wrap up another great four day Early Ford V8 Club of America Meet.


