Subject: Car Show/Parade for Veterans Festival

We are very excited to host the 6th Annual Amber Waves of Grain Craft Beer Festival for Veterans. California largest craft beer festival dedicated to veterans, proceeds from this event to benefit Riverside County veterans. Since 2016 we have raised and distributed over \$225,000 dollars to organizations directly supporting veterans such as Blue Star Mothers (CA30), Christmas Dinner for Homeless Veterans, All American Riders, American Legion, VFW, Marine Corps League, 4 Paws 4 Patriots Service Dogs, and many others. Some examples of disbursed funds include: Christmas Dinner for Homeless Veterans provided transportation and meals for approximately 150 homeless veterans and handed out backpacks filled with essentials, and the Tadpole Foundation which takes veterans to the high Eastern Sierras for hiking and kayaking in Montana for trout fishing and horseback riding.

Background of Organization and Event:

Amber Waves of Grain, assisted by All American Riders and Blue Star Mothers (CA30), is the lead 501(c)3 collecting and disbursing the funds. The Amber Waves of Grain committee is comprised entirely of volunteers which means 100% of the net proceeds are dispersed to all participating non-profit groups supporting the event. *Last year this equated to 76 cents of every dollar raised being distributed to local Veteran non-profit groups.*

The 6th Annual Amber Waves of Grain Craft Beer Festival will be held November 5th, 2022 12:00-4:30 pm at The Shops at Dos Lagos, 2785 Cabot Drive, Corona, CA 92883. A parade will be at the start of the event. This event is organized by veterans for veterans and is designed to bring together craft beer lovers with veterans, with over 40 microbreweries donating all beer being poured. Families, students and individuals will be able to interact with a WWII Veteran, as well as Korean, Vietnam War and Gulf War veterans. The festival kicks off with a parade featuring Active, Guard and Reserve soldiers representing all branches, military vehicles, JROTC cadets, high school bands as well as military and civic leaders. The event also includes a Veteran Organization Park featuring the Veterans Administration, Disabled American Veterans, Cal-Vets, Salvation Army Homeless Veteran Shelter, American Legion, VFW and over 30 non-profit organizations directly supporting our veterans. Historical reenactment groups featuring all periods of the US military will be present as well as a military vehicle and historical reenactment park showcasing WWII uniforms and equipment.
