Inland Mopars, along with Phil & Mary Leatherman of Extreme Automotive, will again be hosting an open house at Extreme Automotive in Corona on Saturday November 12. It is more of a meet & greet but there will be shop tours and free safety inspections provided by the National Street Rod Association Southern California Safety Rep. Food will be provided from 11:00 to 2:00. Popcorn will also be available for those with the munchies.

Extreme Automotive is the home of Wild Thang, the flame throwing exhibition street rod seen the past 3 years at Mopars in May as well as the builder of Swoopy, the '48 Dodge Hemi powered custom.

The one important aspect of this event is it is also part of a larger toy drive for the kids out at Ft. Irwin, located outside of Barstow. Phil & Mary host a Christmas party in December to collect toys which get delivered to Ft. Irwin the next day. Inland Mopars has donated \$300 worth of toys plus toys from the individual members the past two years. Last year we also had a \$250 donation from the Mopar Club of San Diego which went for more toys, which can be seen in one of the photos below being delivered along with toys purchased with t-shirt funds. We had over 60 people attend the 2015 event & would like to see it grow. It is a good way to get the Mopar community to give back a little as the kick off to the toy drive. All we ask is that you donate a new, unwrapped toy valued at \$10 or more.

T-shirts will also be available. \$3.00 from every shirt sold will be donated to the toy drive so additional toys can be purchased. Another \$100 worth of toys were purchased from shirt purchases last year. Call or e-mail if you would like to order prior to the event for t-shirt pickup at the event, or if you can't make it, have it/them shipped to you.

If a new toy is not in the budget, come out anyway & see what is going on. There is a constantly changing car show going on as people come & go. Meet old friends and make new ones. With representatives from 7 Southern California Mopar clubs and many independents, all interested in Mopars, you should be able to find something to talk about.
