### What Does Your Sponsorship Mean



*A grandmother unexpectedly finds herself raising her grandchildren. She's out of patience, out of resources, and out of friends.*

*A teen mother lives with her unemployed boyfriend. Another baby is on the way. They know they shouldn't take out their anger on a child, but don't know how to cope.*

*A divorced mother has five kids under the age of nine. All she sees are problems, no solutions.*

What do they have in common? All are Children's Bureau clients, beneficiaries of programs that involve them in a network of community resources. We offer everything from counseling, to parenting classes, to summer camps for kids who desperately need fun. **Working with hospitals and schools, partnering with Family Resource and Community Centers, Children's Bureau has been helping at-risk and abused kids and their families for more than 100 years.**



Without question, child abuse is one of society's most pervasive and insidious problems. In fact, there were more than 39,000 cases of reported abuse and neglect in Orange County alone last year. Our criminal justice and mental health systems are teeming with those who were victims of child abuse themselves.

Truth is, child abuse prevention makes sense. Once a child has been abused, the cost to society is enormous in both social and economic terms -- \$17,000 a year for a child in foster care and \$61,000 a year for those children who are so badly damaged they require institutional care. However, **it costs just \$3,000 per at-risk family to prevent abuse** from happening in the first place through in-home counseling, support groups and parent education.

Our Orange County programs and services were established in 1987 to meet the increasing needs of vulnerable children and families here. **Children's Bureau currently serves more than 6,000 children and their families annually in Orange County** and has program sites in Anaheim, Fullerton, Huntington Beach, Laguna Hills, and Santa Ana.
